GENERAL MAINTENANCE RECOMMENDATIONS:

- CLEAN THE LUMINAIRE PERIODICALLY TO REMOVE POSSIBLE DIRT DEPOSITS THAT MAY DAMAGE IT OR ALTER THE PHOTOMETRICS PERFORMANCE.
- DO NOT USE HARSH DETERGENTS, ABRASIVE CLOTHES, HIGH- PRESSURE WASHERS, WATER AT A TEMPERATURE HIGHER THAN 60°C TO CLEAN THE LUMINAIRE.
- CHECK THE INTEGRITY OF THE FITTING COMPONENTS: REPLACE THEM IN CASE OF DAMAGE BY USING ONLY ORIGINAL MARECO LUCE PARTS.
- CHECK THE PLASTIC CASINGS CAREFULLY IN ORDER TO IDENTIFY ANY POSSIBLE INSULATION DAMAGE.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Connect the cable out of the fitting (1) to the main supply by respecting the polarities.

CAUTION: For a correct installation, we recommend to ensure a watertight connection between the supply cables and to use only a flexible double insulation sheath (type HAR) or one suitable for outdoor use.

- 2. Secure the fitting on the pole, or wall bracket.
- 3. Remove the diffuser (2) to access to the lamp holder (3).
- 4. Insert the lamp (NOT included with the luminaire).
- 5. Tighten the diffuser (2) and make sure that the gasket is in the correct position.
